

How to Add Courses with Discussion Sections to Your Shopping Cart


<u>Explanation</u>: Some courses meet twice a week as a large group for a lecture and then beak up into groups on a third day for smaller discussion sections so that all students have the chance to contribute to class discussion. For these classes, you must register for both a lecture section and one of the discussion sections paired with it.




Media Studies 202, an introductory course in Media and History, is a good example of a course that has both a lecture and a discussion component.




1. Note the "LEC" in the blue hyperlink of sections 01 and 02 of Media Studies 202. This indicates that these two sections are lecture components of the class.




2. There are three open discussion sections as well, designated by the letters "DIS" in the blue hyperlink.




3. Select the Lecture section you prefer.




- 4. On the next screen, you will see the discussion sections paired with that particular lecture section.
- 5. Select the discussion section you prefer.



6. Click "Next."
